FINANCE

Mr. Verdonik had nothing to report. Mr. Bongiovanni reported that the work on the Deepavaal Force Main break was successfully completed. Trees will be planted in the easement area and the final paving will be done through an interlocal agreement with Fairfield.

Mr. Voorman had nothing to report. Mr. Marotta reported the Governor signed into law the amendments to the OPRA regulations.

LEGAL and PUBLIC RELATIONS

MANAGEMENT REPORT

Mr. Bongiovanni reported that we are still waiting on the pension numbers from the State to finalize the Audit Report. He also discussed the DEP permit fees in the correspondence file. The DEP annual fee, based on effluent quality, was originally assessed at ~\$39,000.00. Some of the data that was used to calculate this fee was taken during a planned partial Plant shutdown. Since TBSA received an Affirmative Defense for this work, the data gathered during this period should not be considered. Mr. DeGraw and Mr. Tillery spearheaded the appeal, and the fee was ultimately reduced to ~\$20,000.00.
